- 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE. To ensure that sex offenders in the custody of or under the supervision of the D.C. Department of Corrections (DOC) are notified regarding their duty to register with the Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA). The DOC hereby establishes guidelines for notifying CSOSA and the Federal Bureau of Prisons (FBOP) when a sex offender is released into the community or sent to a halfway house.
- 2. **PROGRAM OBJECTIVES.** The expected results of this program are:
 - a. DOC shall notify CSOSA before a misdemeanant sex offender is released into the community.
 - DOC shall provide inmate records and information to the CSOSA to assist the agency in carrying out its responsibilities related to registering all sex offenders in the District of Columbia.
 - c. DOC shall notify each sex offender both orally and in writing of the duty to register with the CSOSA. This notification must be made before the sex offender's release into the community.

3. NOTICE OF NON-DISCRIMINATION

a. In accordance with the D.C. Human Rights Act of 1977, as amended, D.C. Official Code § 2-1401.1 et seq., (act) the District of Columbia does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, marital status, personal appearance, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, familial status, family responsibilities, matriculation, political affiliation, genetic information, disability, source of income, status as a victim of an intrafamily offense, or place of residence or business. Sexual harassment in the form of sex discrimination is also prohibited by the act. Discrimination in violation of the act will not be tolerated. Violators will be subject to disciplinary action.

6. **CERTIFICATION OF SEX OFFENDER AND NOTICE ORDER.** When an inmate is sentenced and the court orders the inmate to register as a sexual offender, the court should issue a Certification of Sex Offender and Notice Order with Judgment and Commitment (J&C) Order. The DOC Records Office shall follow up with the courts when the order is not forwarded with the Judgment and Commitment Order.

7. SEX OFFENDER IDENTIFICATION AND DOCUMENTATION.

- a. Upon entry into DOC custody, all inmates are photographed.
- After notification, from the court or other source, that an inmate has been certified as a sex offender, the Records Office is responsible for identifying and documenting each offender. The Records Office will place a detainer on the inmate in the Jail and Community Corrections System (JACCS) (Attachment 3).
- Once the inmate has been identified as a certified sex offender, his/her photograph along with other identifying documents will be forwarded to CSOSA.
- d. Prior to sex offenders release from DOC custody, Case Management will advise the inmate, both orally and in writing of his/her obligation to register as a sex offender with CSOSA within three (3) days of release. The inmate will complete the Sex Offender Form (Attachment 1) and the Sex Offender Registration Information Form (Attachment 2) and forward to the Records Office to be placed in the inmate's institutional file. During the release process, the Records Office will release the detainer previously placed in JACCS (Attachment 4).
- e. When the Federal Bureau of Prisons (FBOP) requires a sex offender in DOC custody to complete the FBOP sex offender registration form, Case Management is responsible for having the inmate complete the FBOP form, and returning the completed form to the FBOP.

- f. Prior to release from DOC custody, each sex offender shall receive a copy of his or her completed Sex Offender Notification Form (Attachment 1) informing them that they must register as a sex offender with CSOSA within three (3) days of release.
- 8. **NOTICE TO CSOSA.** Upon notification, from the court or other source, that an inmate has been certified as a sex offender, DOC will complete and forward a copy of all offender notification forms to CSOSA.
- 9. **INMATE NOTIFICATION.** The Deputy Warden or designee shall ensure that each sex offender is provided the following information before the individual is released or transferred to a halfway house:
 - a. The sex offender must read the Sex Offender Notification Form (Attachment
 1) evidencing the duties of the sex offender and penalties for noncompliance with the registration requirements.
 - b. If the accused sex offender disagrees with a determination that he or she is required to register as a sex offender or must register as a sex offender for life under SORA, he or she must provide CSOSA with notice of their intent to seek review of the determination, and within thirty (30) days of providing such notice, file a motion seeking review of the determination with the Court.
 - c. The sex offender has a legal obligation to report any change of address, and or duty to update any other change in their registration information.
 - d. If the sex offender lives in another state, moves to another state, or works or attends school in another state, the sex offender must also report this information, and must register in any such state.
- 10. **RELEASE OF INFORMATION.** In accordance with existing law, sex offender information may be released as follows:
 - a. Sex offender information may be released to law enforcement agencies for law enforcement purposes.
 - b. Sex offender information may be released to government agencies conducting confidential background investigations.
