


DC Department of Corrections Operating Budget and Net Expenditure




FY 2021 Budget by Service






Department of Corrections Full Time Employees (FTE)




FY 2021 FTE Distribution by Grade

Average Daily Population by Fiscal Year DC Department of Corrections (DOC) Total and Central Detention Facility (CDF)



Average Daily Population by Calendar Year DC Department of Corrections (DOC) Total and Central Detention Facility (CDF)






Average Daily Population Mid-FY 2021 by Sex and Facility







Average Daily Population CY 2021 by Sex and Facility







Intakes and Releases by Fiscal Year








Intakes and Releases by Calendar Year




Inmate Population by Race

Blacks are overrepresented compared to the DC population which is 46% Black. 
Inmate Religious Affiliations

Self Declared Education Levels for Inmates




As of March 31, 2021, 60.7% of men and 41.6% of women in custody report having at least a GED or a High School Diploma. All data is self reported by inmates.





Age Distribution of Men




The median age of men is 32 years. The median age for all DOC inmates is 32 years.


Inmates by Sex



Stated Residency




Population by Race







Age Distribution of Women










Percent of Men in Custody by Legal Status and

Average Length of Stay in Days






The median age for men is **32** years; average length of stay is **345.8** days and the median length of stay is **223.3** days. Approximately **92.8%** are held on felony charges and **7.2%** on misdemeanor charges.

Percent of Women in Custody by Legal Status and Average Length of Stay in Days




The median age for women is **34.2** years; average length of stay is **291.9** days and the median length of stay is **133.8** days. Approximately **86.4%** are held on felony charges and **10.6%** are misdemeanor charges.


Offenses by Most Serious Active Charge - Men

Offenses by Most Serious Active Charge - Women




Approximately 35.5% of women are incarcerated on violent or dangerous offenses (per DC Code 22 Section 4501)

Men LOS








Mid-FY 2021 Releases by Length of Stay - Men









Mid-FY 2021 Releases by Length of Stay - Women








CY 2021 Releases by Length of Stay - Men




The median length of stay for released men at Q1, CY 2021 was **55** days; **41.7**% stayed fewer than 31 days.






CY 2021 Releases by Length of Stay - Women



The median length of stay for released women in Q1, CY 2021 was **49.2** days; **44.9** % stayed fewer than 31 days.







Re-Incarceration Rate History by Fiscal Year (FY) and Calendar Year (CY)



During the Fiscal Year (FY) DOC measures the percent of the population within a 12-month period who were released by Number of Bookings from March 31, 2020 through March 31,2021, for example the percent of inmates who had only one booking (intake), or multiple intakes within a 12-month period. Those who returned on a new booking during the period recidivated.





During the Calendar Year (CY), DOC measures the percent of the population within a 12-month period who were released by Number of Bookings from Year over Year beginning in January and ending in December, for example the percent of inmates who had only one booking (intake), or multiple intakes within the calendar year. Those who returned on a new booking during the period recidivated.
