





FY 2013 Budget by Service







FY 2013 FTE Distribution by Grade



DC Department of Corrections (DOC) Total and Central Detention Facility (CDF)





Average Daily Population FY 2012 by Sex and Facility









Average Daily Population CY 2012 by Sex and Facility






Central Detention Facility














DC Resident Inmates by Ward of Residence









Age Distribution of Male Inmates







Inmates by Sex




Age Distribution of Female Inmates

Inmate Population by Race



The category "Other" includes Native Americans and those who have declared their race as Other. Undeclared includes the few who have not declared a race.. Blacks are overrepresented compared to the DC population which is 55% Black. 

Self Declared Education Levels for Male Inmates





Self Declared Education Levels for Female Inmates





Religious Affiliation of Intakes FY 2012







Religious Affiliation of Intakes of Islamic Faith







Approximately 31.8 % of male inmates are incarcerated on violent or dangerous offenses (per DC Code 22 Section 4501).







Length of Stay Distribution for Inmates in Custody




Male Inmates

CY 2012 Male Releases by Length of Stay




The median length of stay for released male inmates in FY 2012 was 28 days; 53 % of males released stayed fewer than 31 days.

The release profile for the population as a whole is nearly identical to that for male inmates. The median length of stay for all released inmates for CY 2012 was 27 days.

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

by Frequency of Release FY 2012



The FY 2012 one year re-incarceration rate was 22.2% for all inmates, this is 5.2 % higher than the one year re-incarceration rate in FY 2010 and similar to that in FY 2011. Non-federal inmates who are re-incarcerated have a significantly higher incidence of mental illness, but are similar to federal offenders who are re-incarcerated in most other attributes. Increase in property crimes and reduced levels of social services may have contributed to the increase in re-incarceration rate.

Inmate Suicide Statistics



- The DOC Inmate Suicide rate for the period FY 2006 through FY 2010 was 4 suicides for 90,730 intakes or a rate of 4.4 per 100,000 intakes.
- The average rate of suicide for the 50 largest jails for the 2000-2007 period was 26 per 100,000 intakes; at that time DC DOC had a rate of 19 per 100,000 intakes.
