



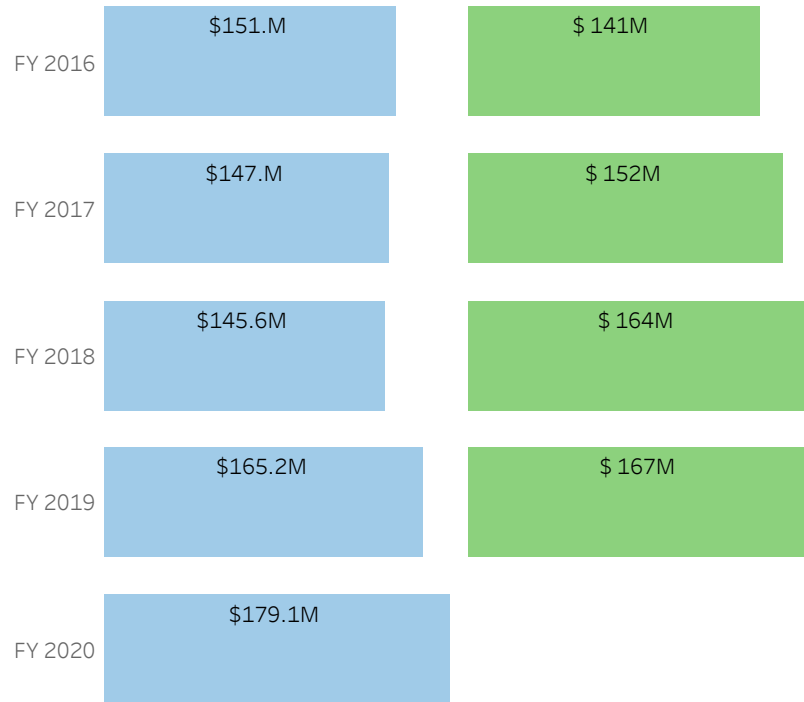

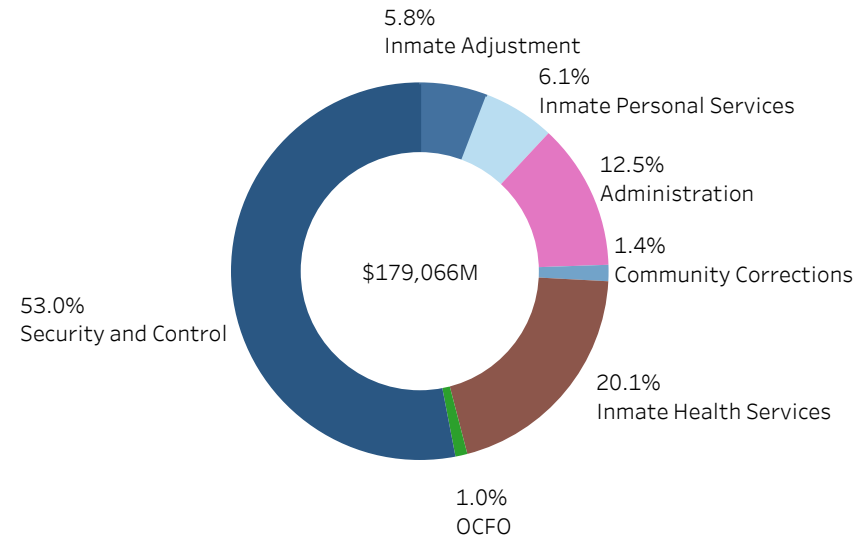

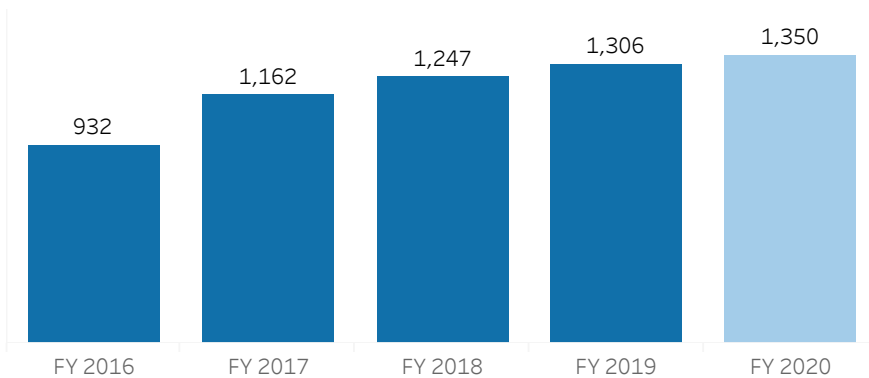


DOC FY20 Operating Budget by Division

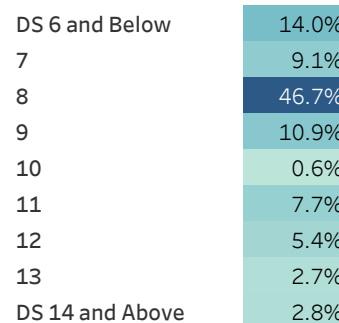

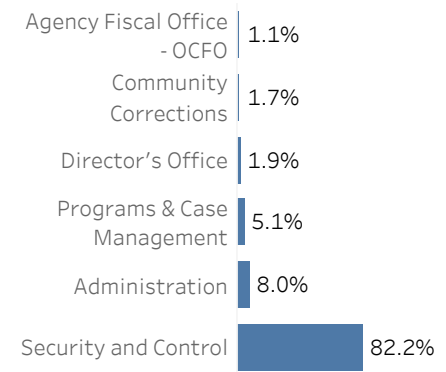
DOC Full Time Employees



FY 2020 FTE Grade Distribution



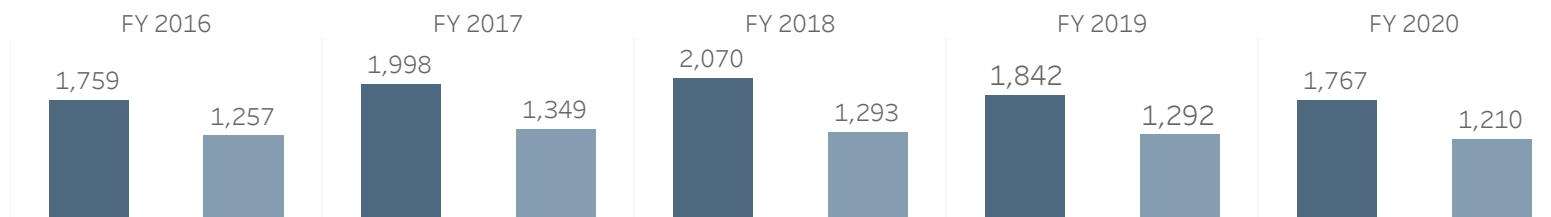
FTE by Division





Average Daily Population by Fiscal Year

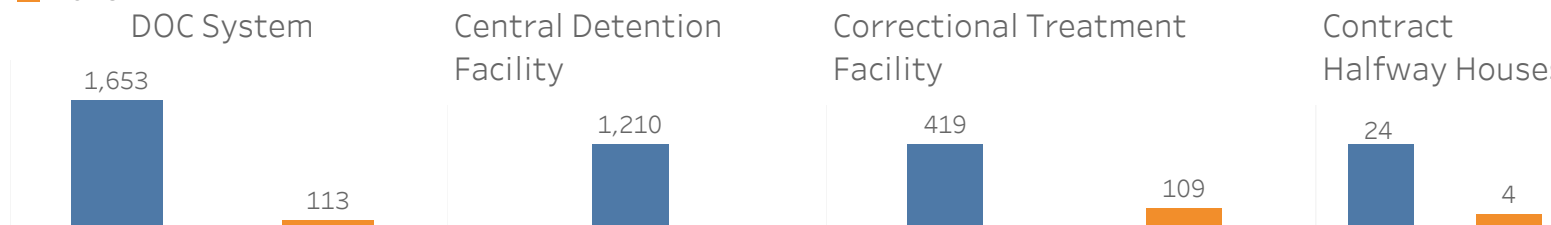

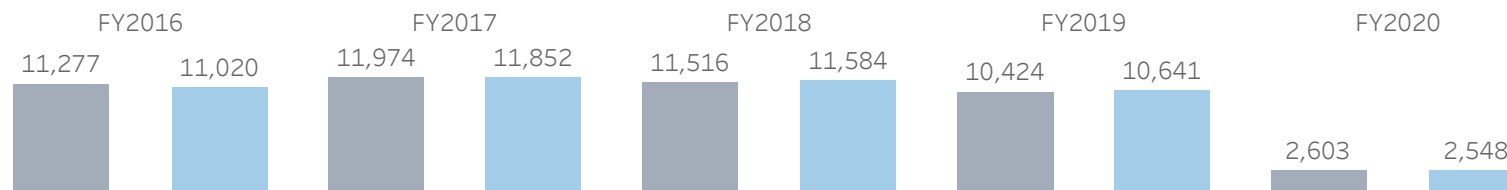
Average Daily Population FY 2020 by Sex and Facility

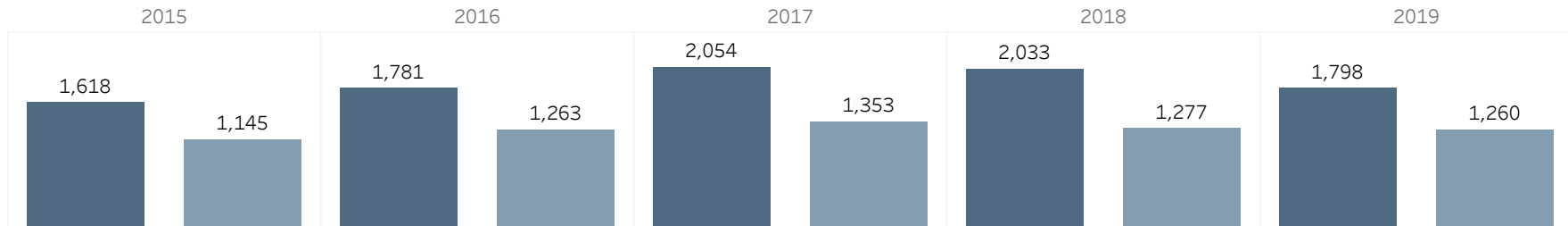

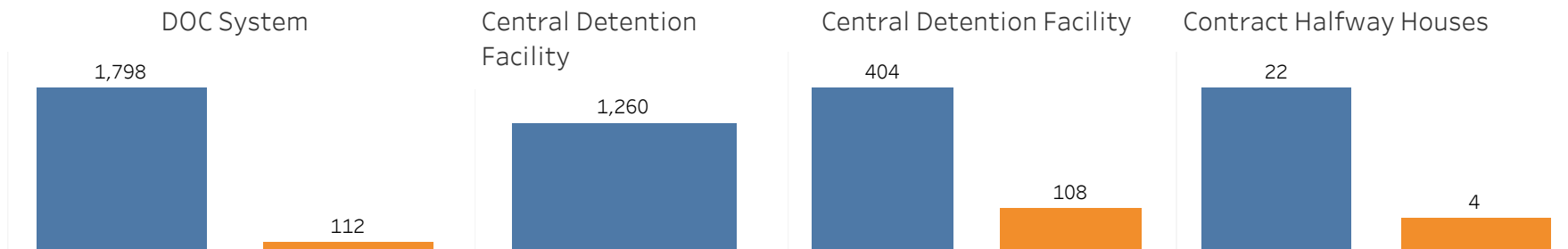
Average Daily Population by Calendar Year

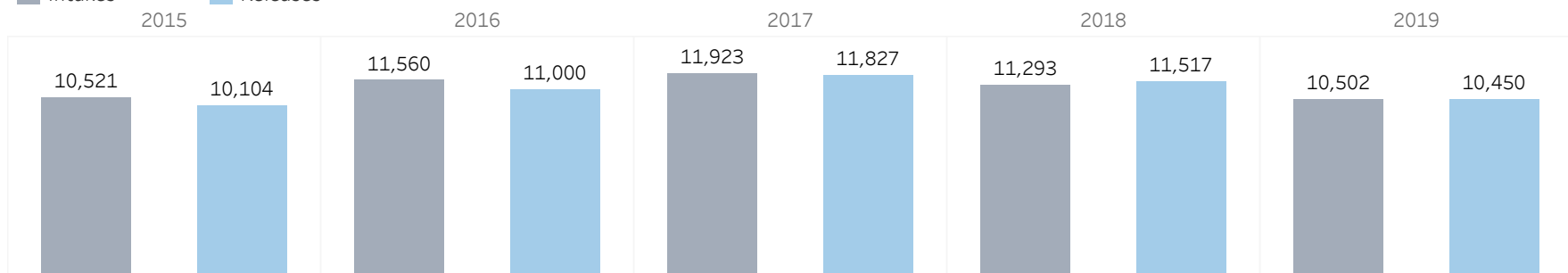

Average Daily Population Calendar Year 2019 by Sex and Facility



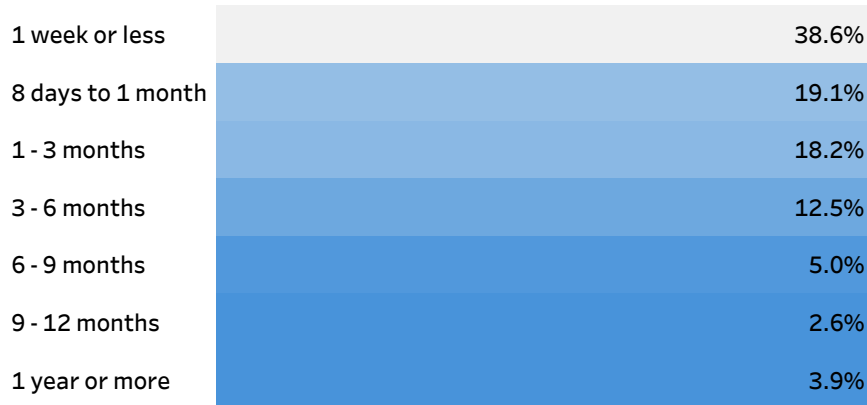

Releases by Length of Stay



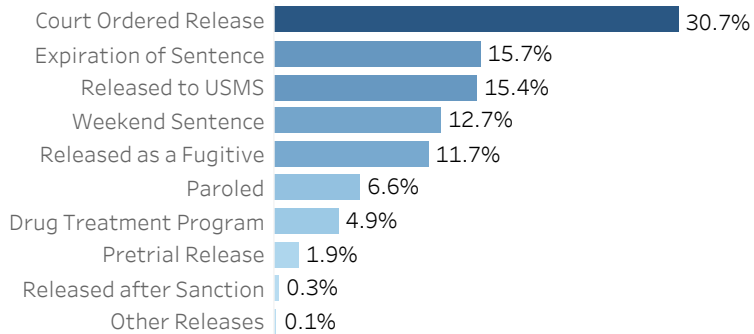
Men: Average LOS was 73.9 days and the Median LOS was 18.7 days; 57.7% stayed fewer than 31 days.

Release by Length of Stay

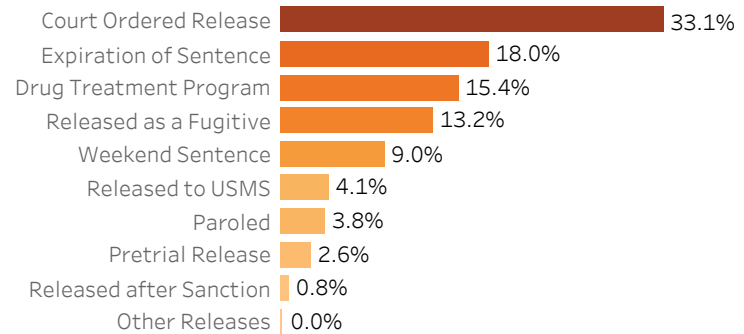


Women: Average LOS was 36.4 days and the Median LOS was 9.9 days; 74.6% stayed fewer than 31 days.

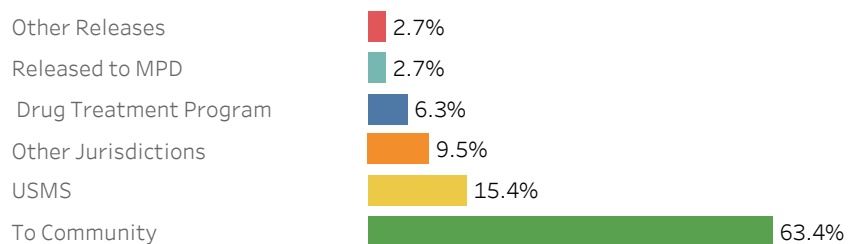

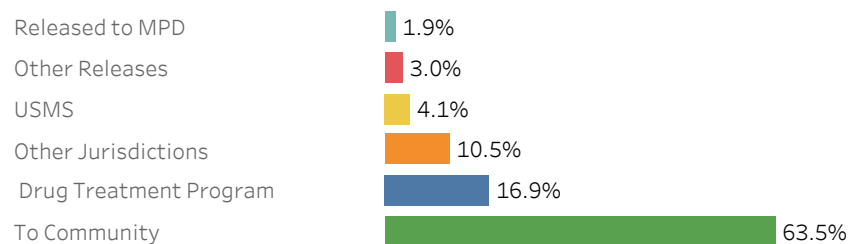

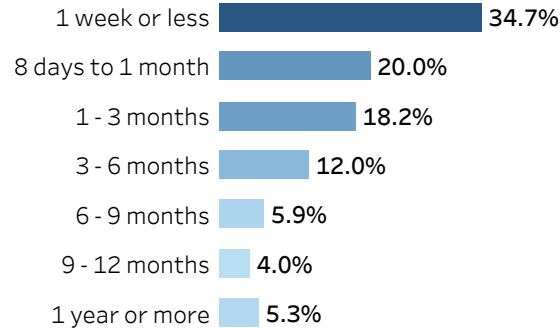

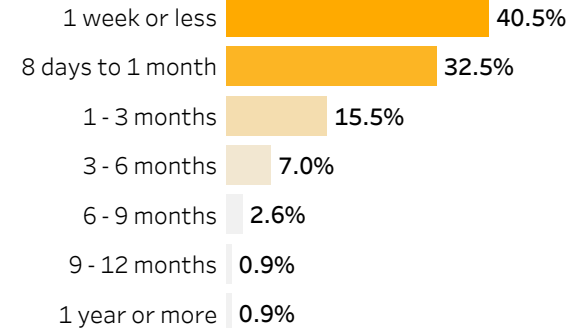

Releases by Length of Stay



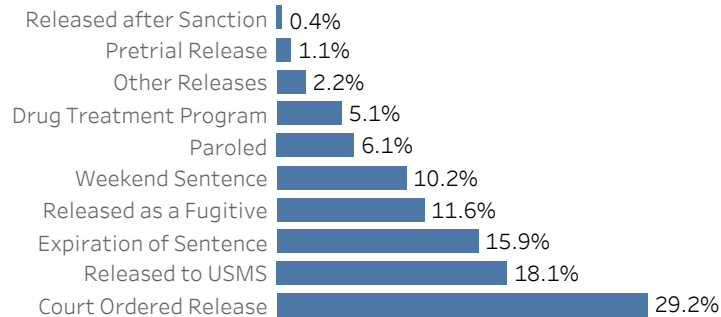

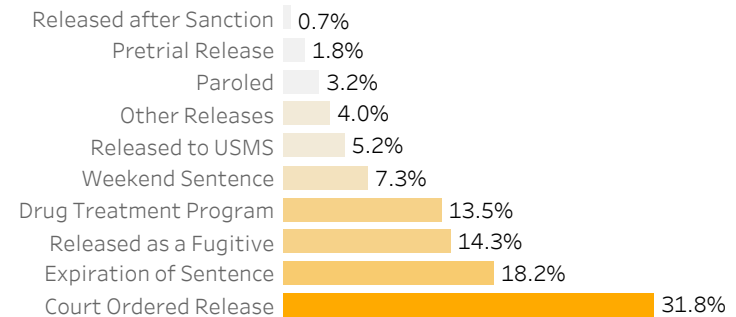
Men: Average LOS was **86.1** days and the Median LOS was **23.1** days; **54.7%** stayed fewer than **31** days.

Women: Average LOS was **38.4** days and the Median LOS was **14** days; **73%** stayed fewer than **31** days.

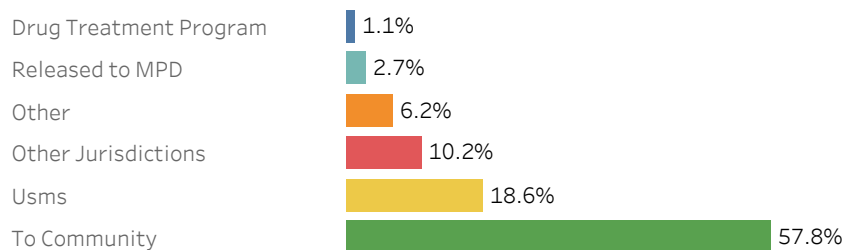

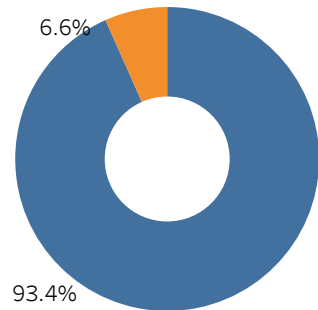

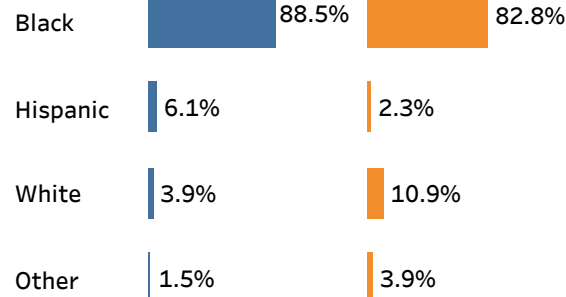

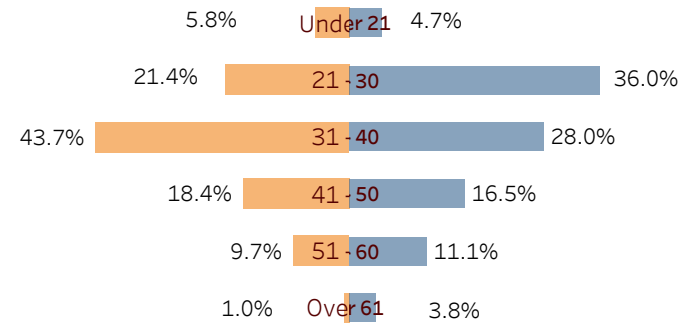
Men and Women in Custody

Race by Gender

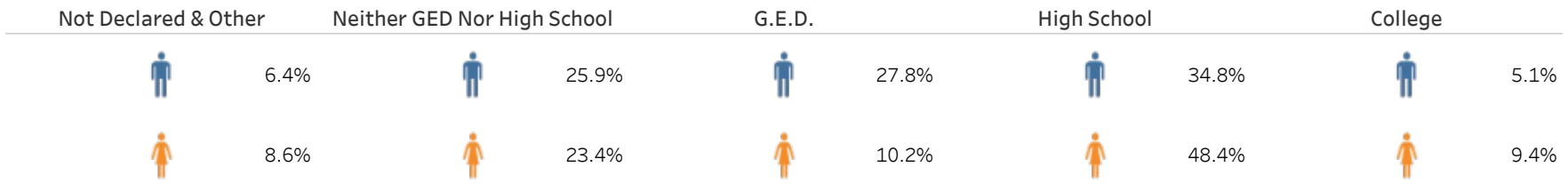

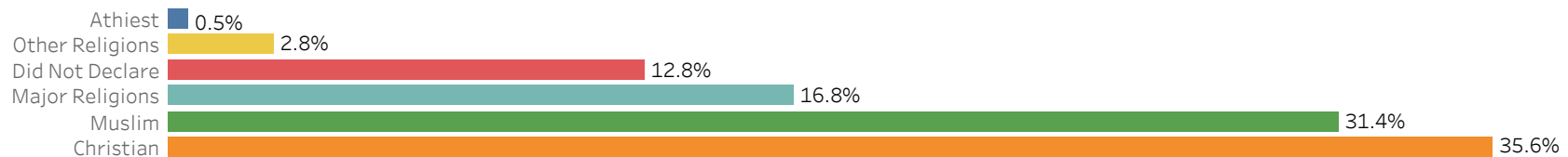

65.6% of men and 58.6% of women in custody report having at least a High School Diploma or a GED. All data is self reported by inmates in DOC custody.

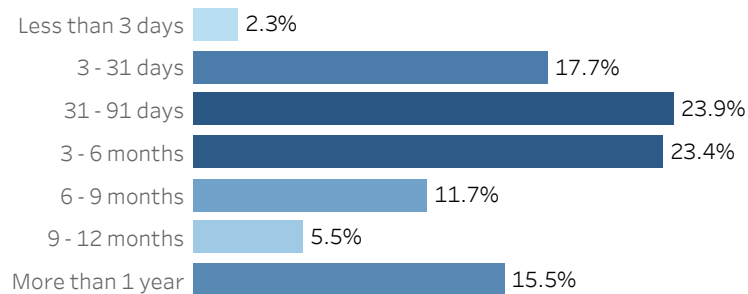

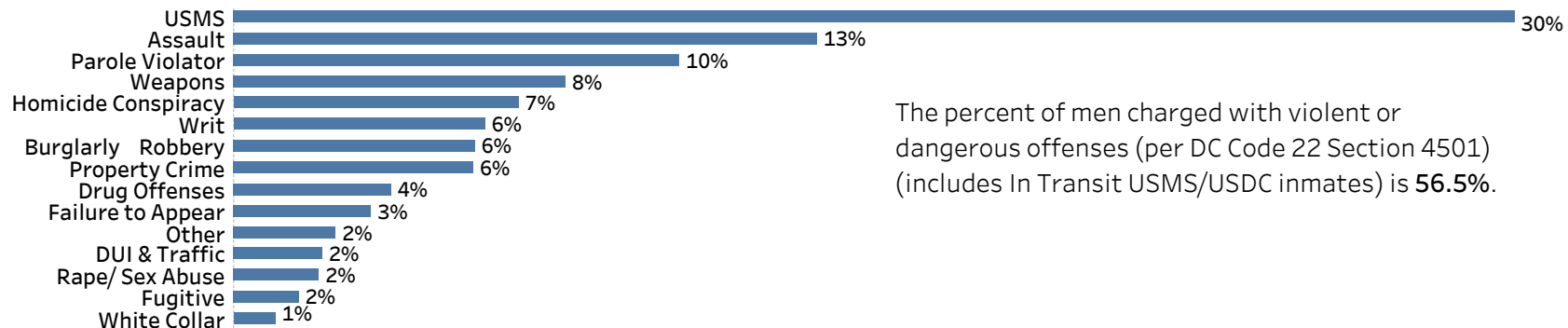

Offenses by Most Serious Active Charges for Men



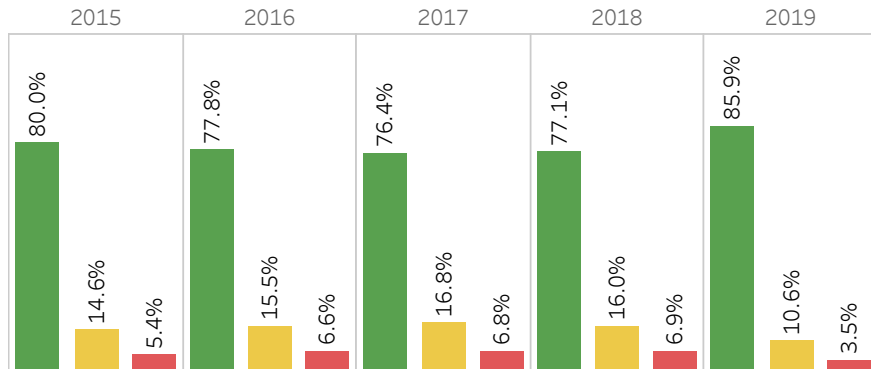

Re-Incarceration Rate History by Calendar Year (CY) and Fiscal Year (FY)

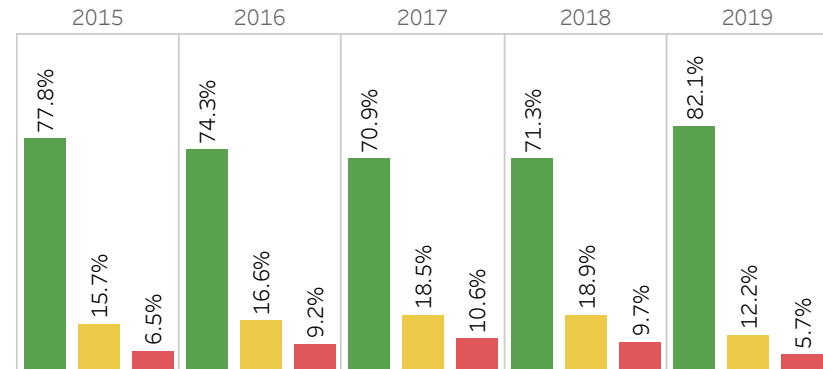

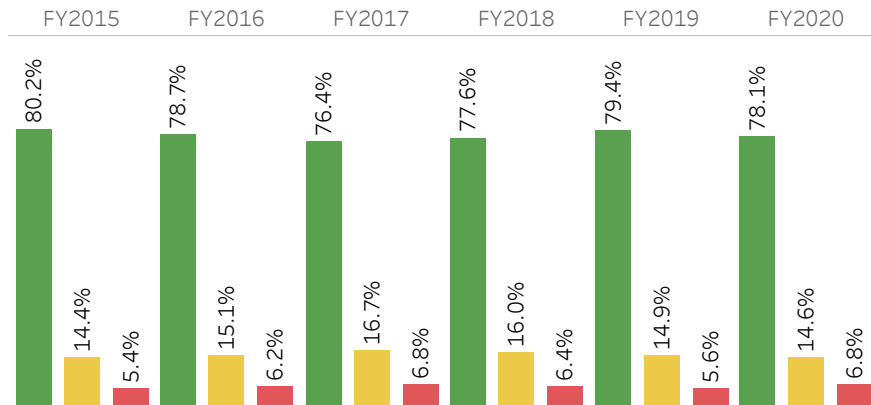
Re-Incarceration Rate for Women by Frequency



DOC measures the percent of the population within a 12 month period who were released by Number of Bookings, for example the percent of inmates who had only one booking (intake), or multiple intakes within a 12 month period. Those who returned on a new booking during the period recidivated.
