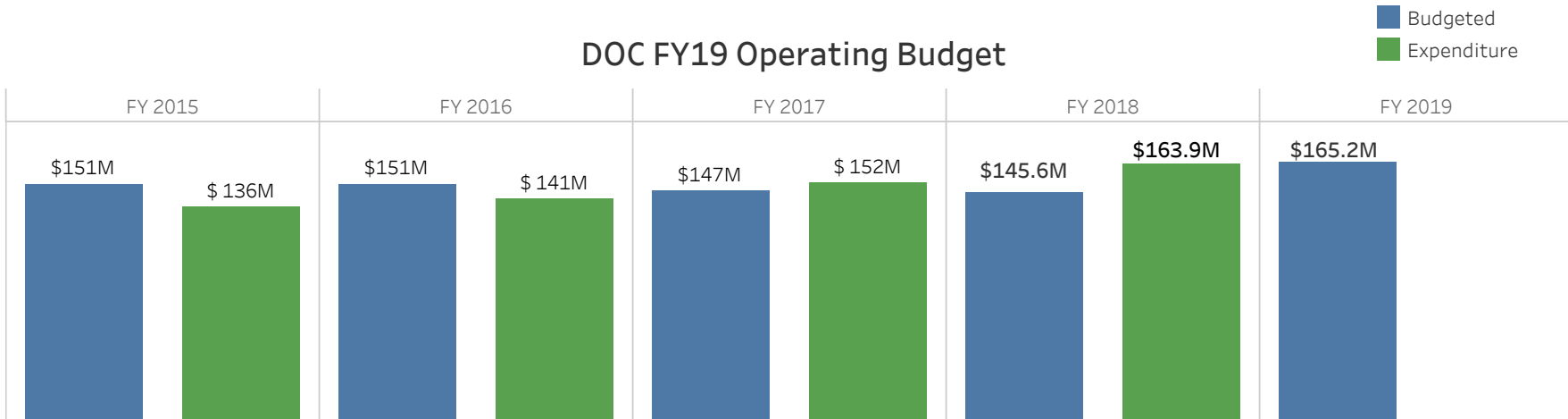

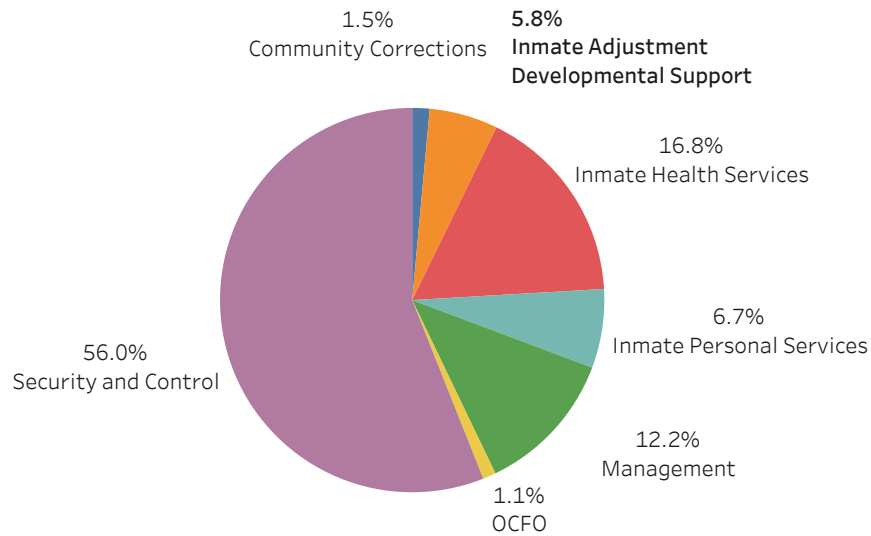

DOC FY19 Operating Budget

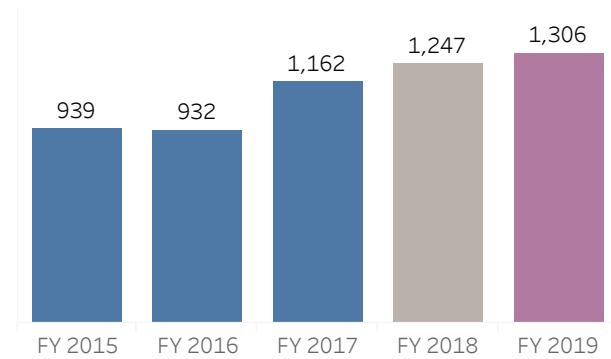

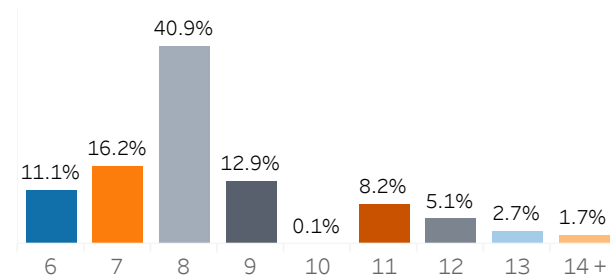
FY 2019 Budget by Service



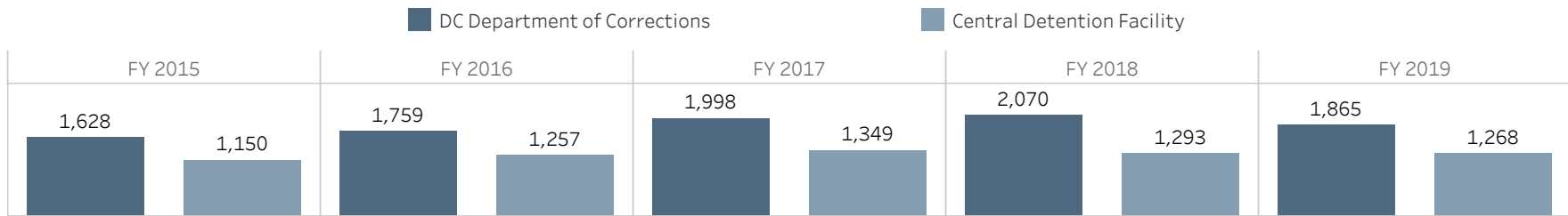
DOC Full Time Employees



FY 2019 FTE Distribution by Grade

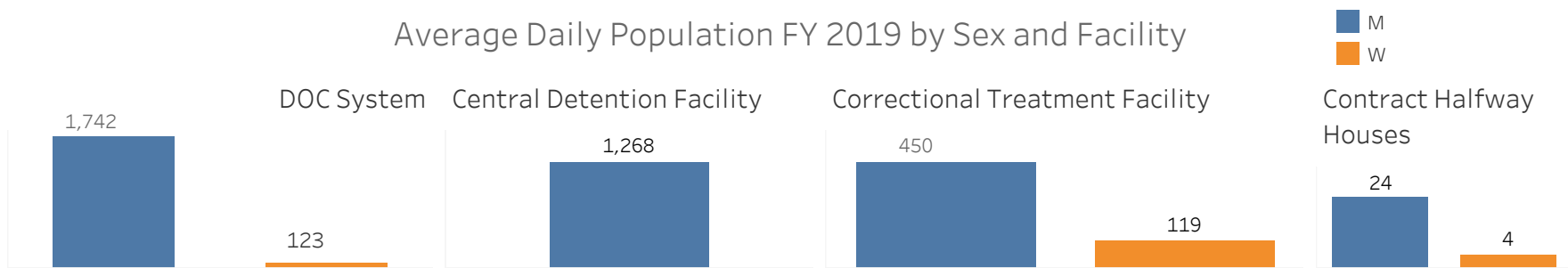


Average Daily Population by Fiscal Year

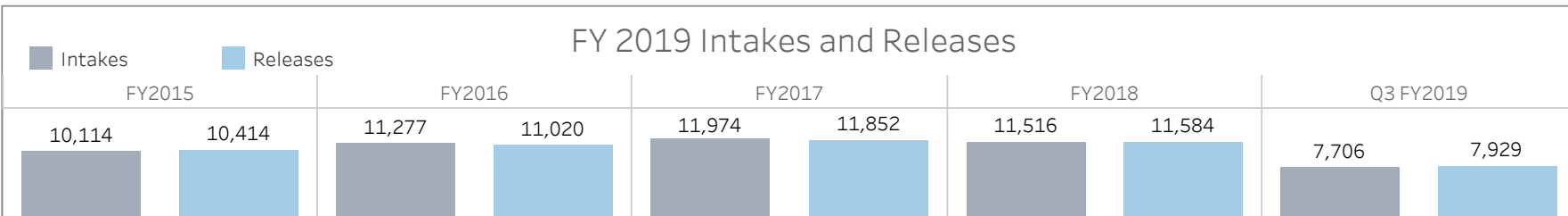

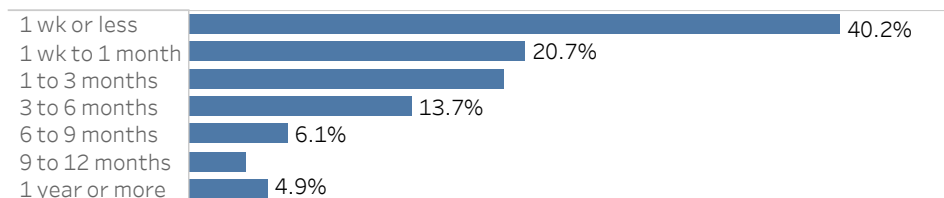
Average Daily Population FY 2019 by Sex and Facility



FY 2019 Intakes and Releases

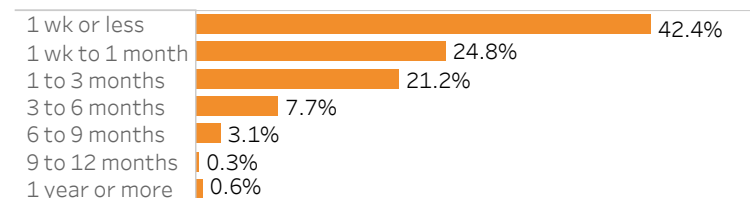


Men - FY 2019 Releases by Sex and Length of Stay



Men: Average LOS was **92.4** days and the Median LOS was **19.9** days; **60.9%** stayed fewer than **31** days.

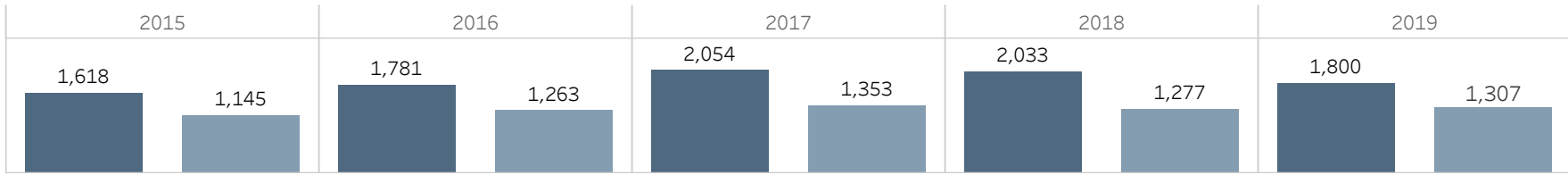
Women FY 2019 Releases by Sex and Length of Stay



Women: Average LOS was **42** days and the Median LOS was **14** days; **67.2%** stayed fewer than **31** days.

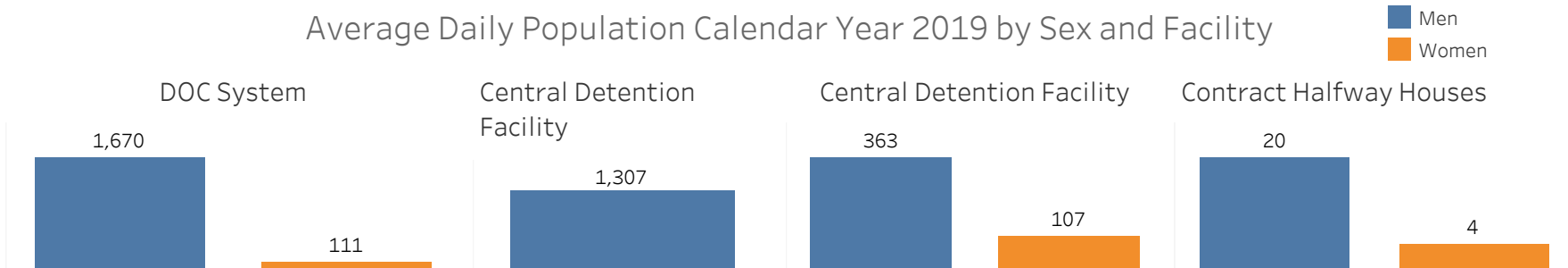

Average Daily Population by Calendar Year



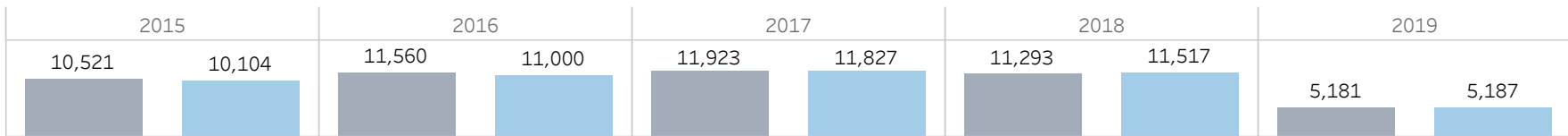

Average Daily Population Calendar Year 2019 by Sex and Facility

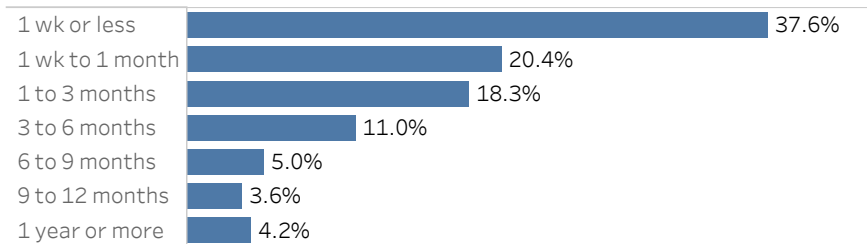

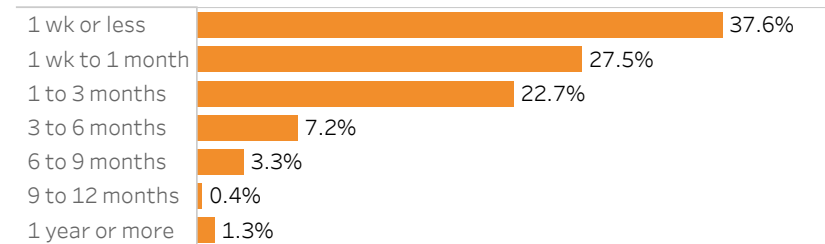
Calendar Year 2019 Intakes and Releases

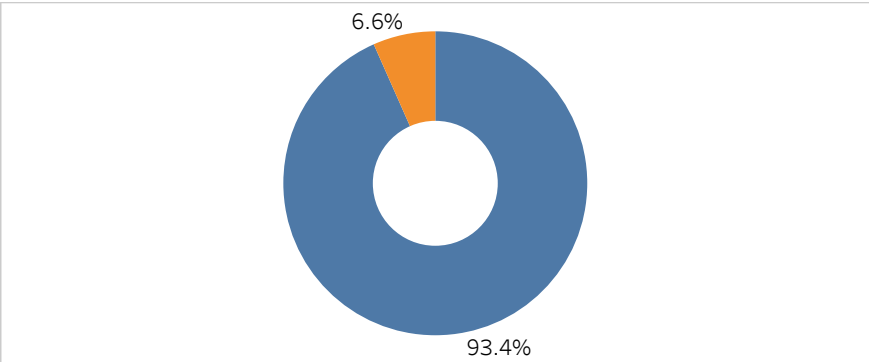


Men: Average LOS was **80** days and the Median LOS was **20.7** days; **58%** stayed fewer than **31** days..

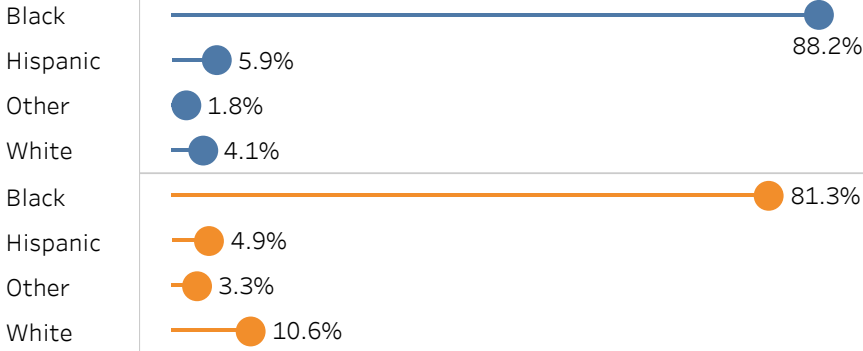
Women: Average LOS was **44.9** days and the Median LOS was **15.9** days; **65.1%** stayed fewer than **31** days.

Men and Women in Custody by Gender

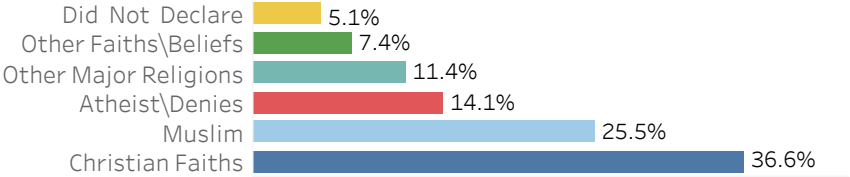


Inmate Race by Gender



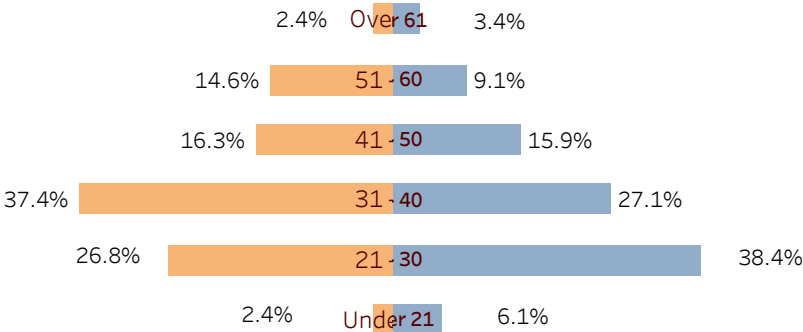
The category "Other" includes Native Americans and those who have declared their race as Other or not declared a race. Blacks are overrepresented compared to the DC population which is 47.7% Black. Whites, Hispanics, and Asians are under-represented compared to the DC population which is 44.6% White, 10.9% Hispanic, 4.1% Asian and 0.8% Other. DC Population Data from www.census.gov

All data is self-reported by intakes that were in custody between October 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019. The category "Other Major Religions" includes other faiths such as Jewish, Buddhist, Hindu and Rastafarian which occur infrequently among intakes.

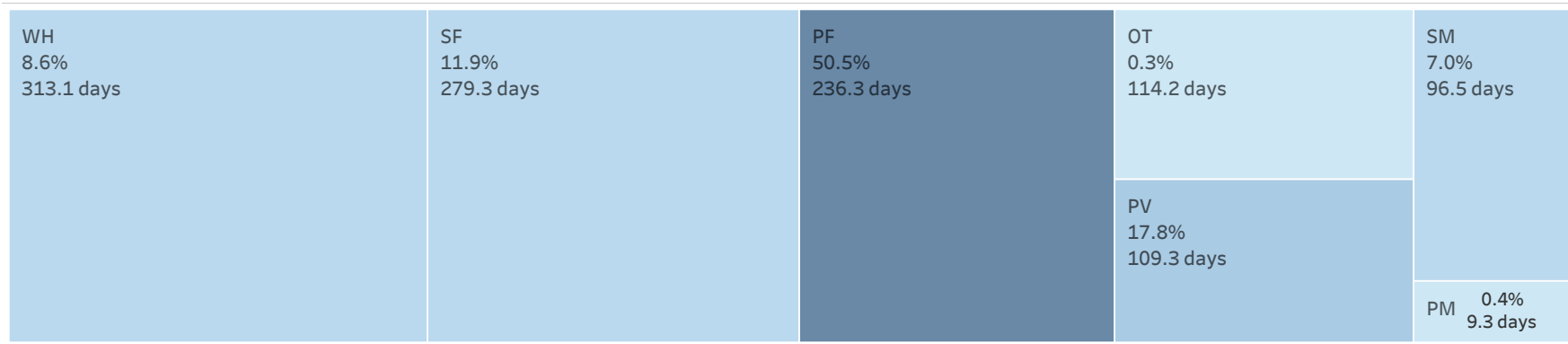

64.3% of men and 47.4% of women in custody report having at least a High School Diploma or a GED. All data is self reported by inmates in DOC custody.

Percent of Men in Custody by Legal Status and Average LOS (days)

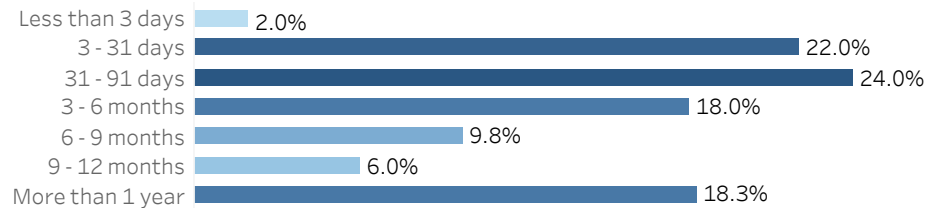


- **Other(O)** Indicates other charges.
- **Pretrial Felon (PF)** means at least one unresolved legal matter exists and indicates the most serious offense requiring detention is a felony.
- **Pretrial Misdemeanant (PM)** means at least one unresolved legal matter exists and indicates that the individual has no felony offenses.
- **Parole Violator (PV)** indicates an individual who has violated conditions of parole, probation or release.
- **Sentenced Felon (SF)** indicates the inmate is serving at least one sentence and indicates the most serious offense requiring detention is a felony.
- **Sentenced Misdemeanant (SM)** indicates the inmate is serving at least one sentence and indicates that the inmate has no felony offenses.
- **Writ/Hold (WH)** individuals may have other charges (typically in transit, fugitive) requiring legal resolution. Only 4% of all inmates are detained solely on a writ.

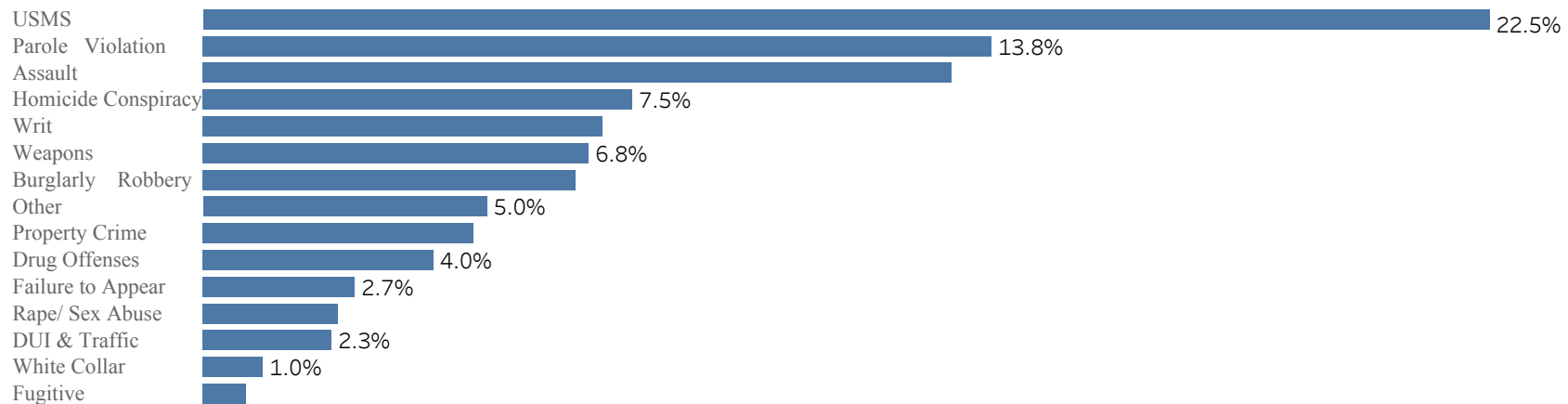

Length of Stay (LOS) Distribution for Men in Custody

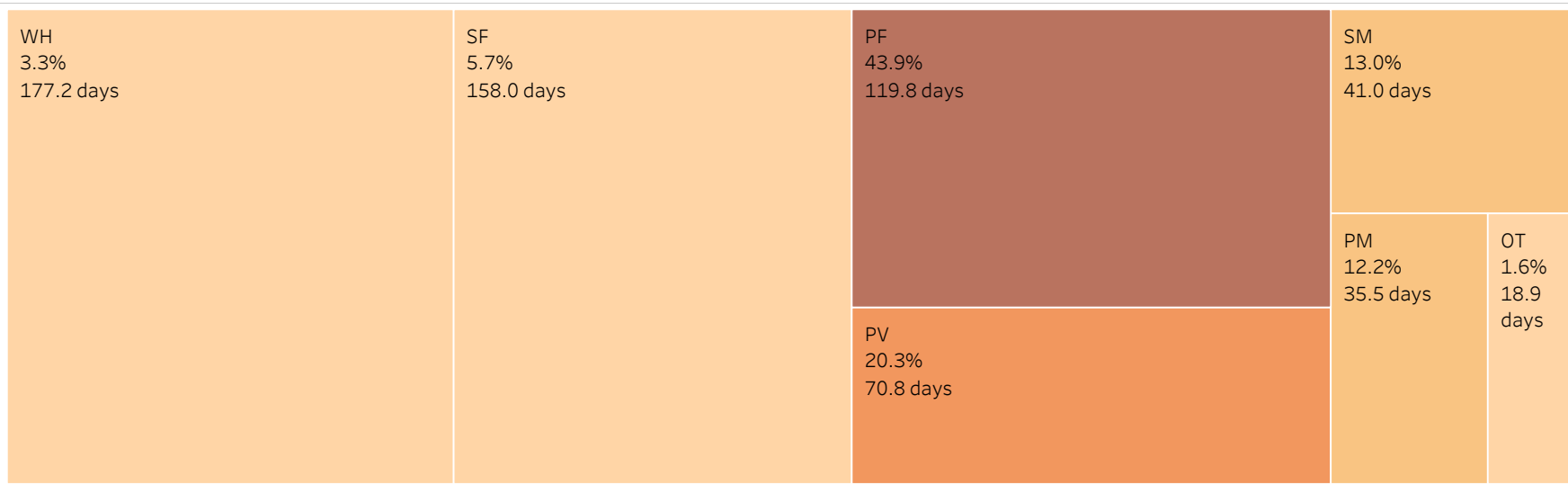

Percent of Women in Custody by Legal Status and Average LOS (days)

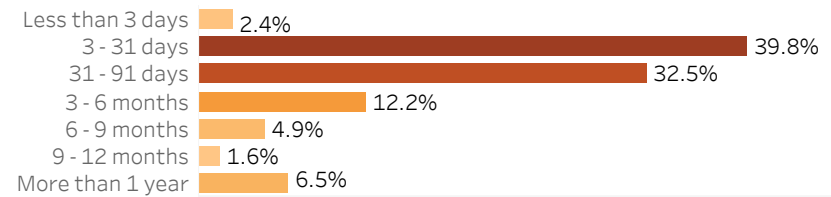

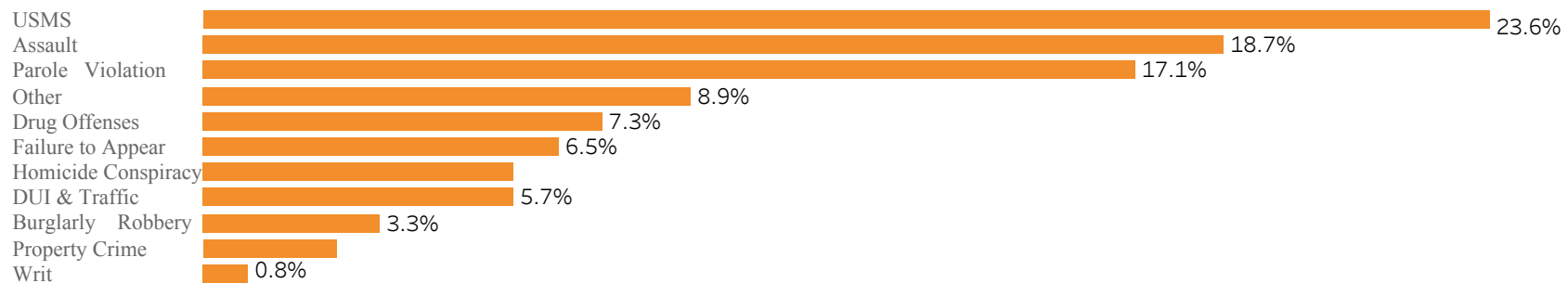

(Average LOS for Women is **110.2** days and Median LOS is **40.6** days)



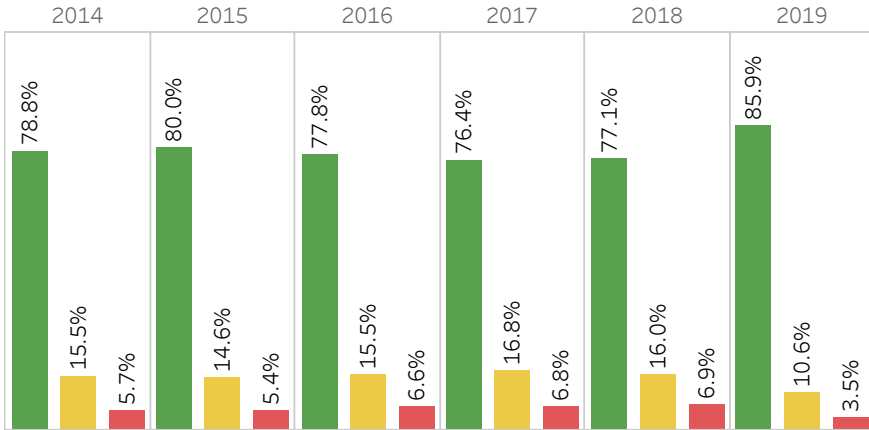
Women Offense by Most Serious Active Charge



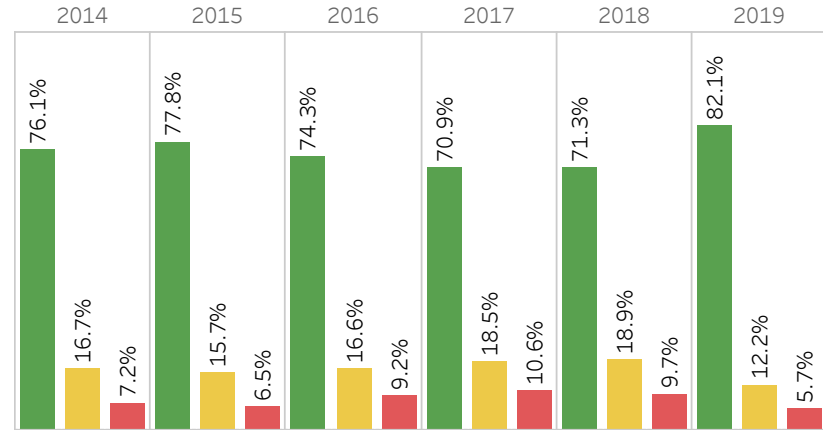

Re-Incarceration Rate History by CY and FY

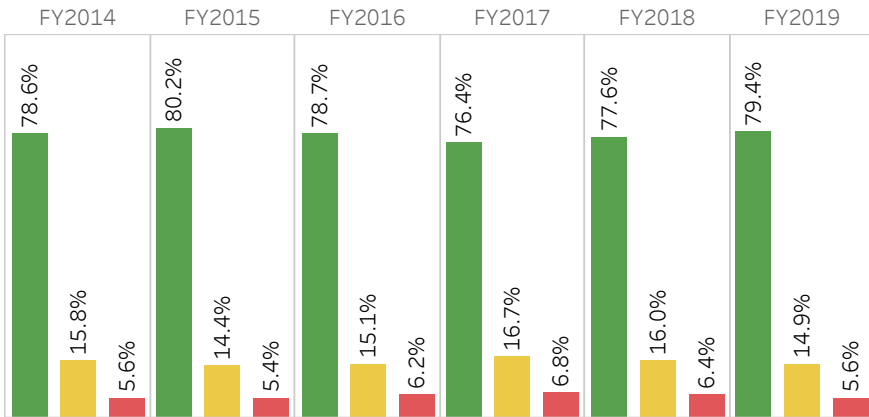
CY 2014 through Q2 CY 2019 Re-Incarceration Rate for Men by Frequency
