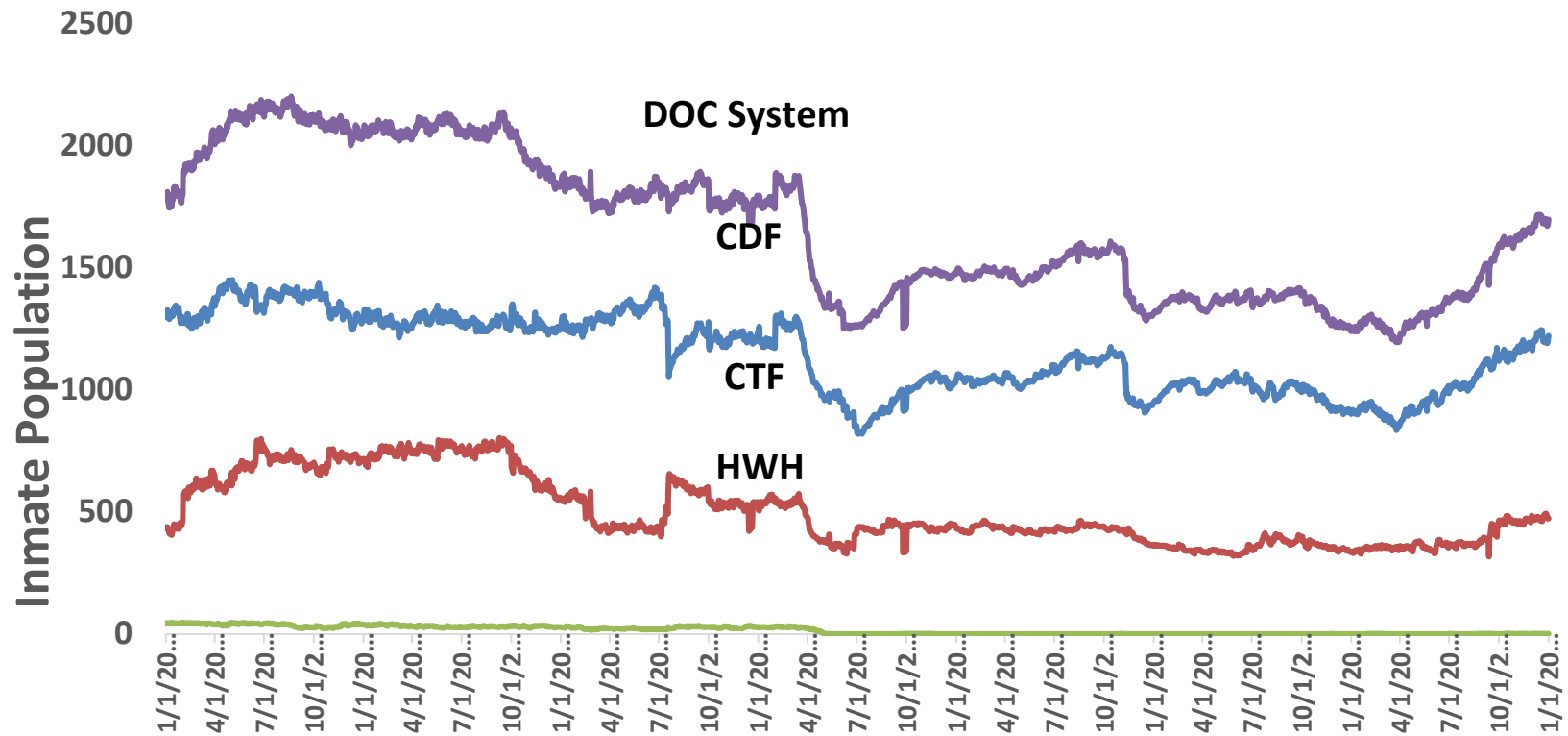


## DOC Population Statistics

### Average Daily Population for January 2017 through December 2023

Average Daily Inmate Population is presented by DC Department of Corrections by facility type from January 2017 through December 2023. The inmate population shows a slight decline in the jail population from over 1400 inmates in January 2021 to 1364 inmates in March 2022, nearly a 11% decrease; but subsequently the population increased to 1696 the end of December 2023. After the passage of laws pertaining to weapons related offenses on July 9, 2023, the custodial population increased at an average rate of 44 per month. Those held for aggravated assault, assault, domestic violence threats or stalking; homicide, conspiracy, or kidnapping; weapons; USMS/USDC inmates; robbery, carjacking, or burglary; and parole or release violations, accounted for approximately 80% of the incarcerated population as of December 31, 2023.
