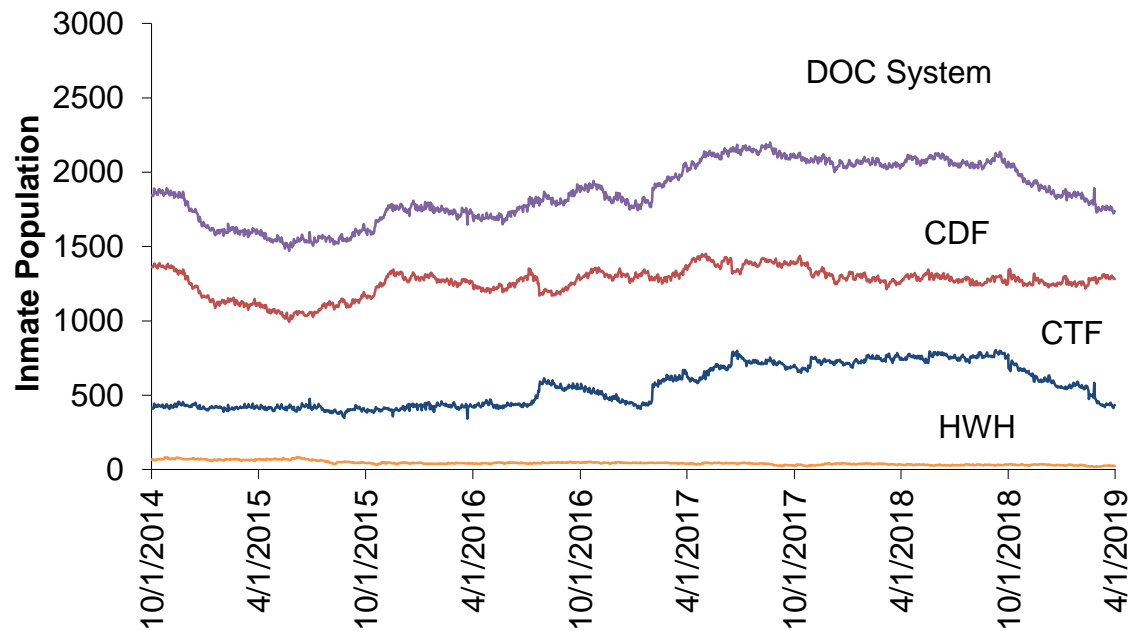


## DOC Population Statistics

### Average Daily Population for October 2014 through March 2019

Average Daily Inmate Population is presented by DC Department of Corrections by facility type for October 2014 through March 2019. The inmate population shows a downward trend for the period of October 2014 through May 2015, with slight seasonal variation resulting in a drop of over 1600 inmates. Since June 2015 there had been a continuous increase in the population of about 500 inmates. For the first and second quarters of FY19--October 2018 through March 2019-- there has been a decline in jail population from over 2000 inmates in October 2018 to slightly under 1754 inmates in March 2019. Those charged with assault, parole or release violation, US District Court or US Marshall's Service commitments, and robbery or burglary accounted for approximately 36% of the incarcerated as of March 31, 2019.



*As of February 2017 both Short Term Sentenced Felons (STSF) and United States Marshall Service (USMS) Inmates will be included in the CTF Population count.*
