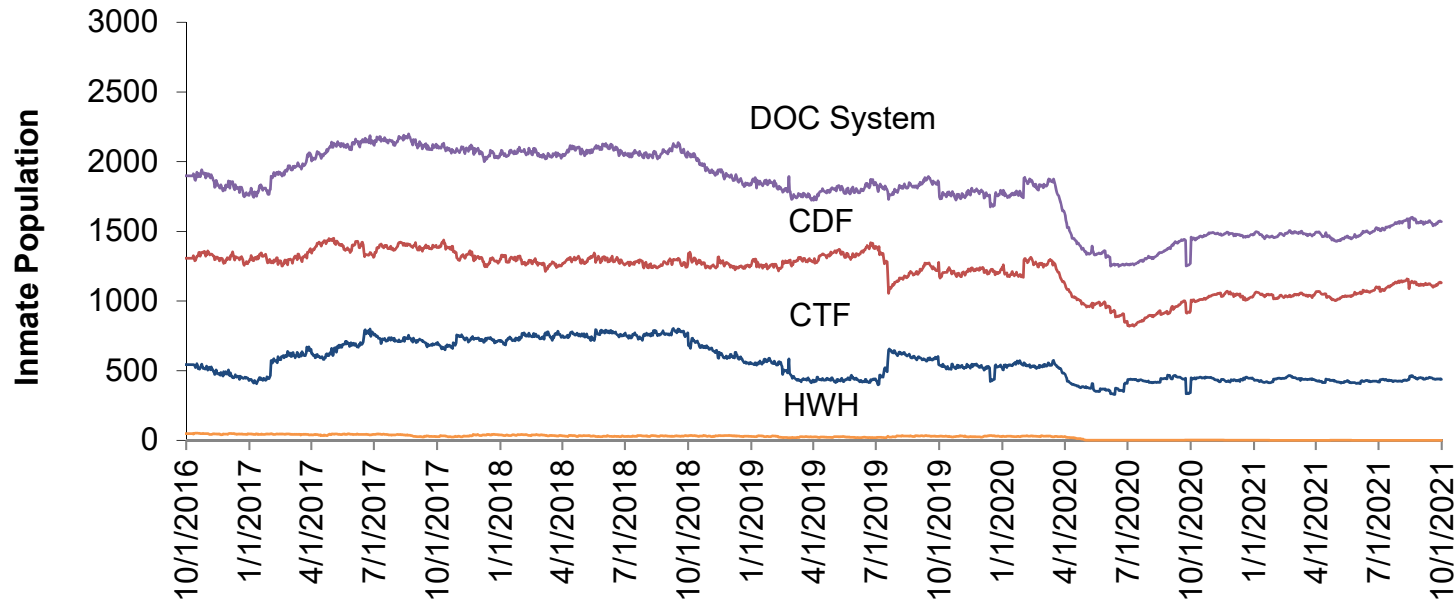

Average Daily Population for October 2017 through September 2021

Average Daily Inmate Population is presented by DC Department of Corrections by facility type from October 2016 through September 2021. The inmate population shows a decline in the jail population from over 2100 inmates in September 2018 to 1482 inmates in June 2021, a 30% decrease. After reopening post-COVID in July 2021, the population gradually increased. Those held for the USMS, charged with assault; homicide, conspiracy, or kidnapping; parole or release violation; weapons; robbery, carjacking or burglary; and arson or property crimes accounted for approximately 75% of the incarcerated as of September 30, 2021.

The CDF population did not exceed the legislated cap of 2164 during the period. As of June 2021, approximately 2 short term sentenced felons in a program run by the FBOP at the CTF and 123 USMS Greenbelt inmates are included in the CTF counts. Note a correction was made to the CTF count which inadvertently did not include FOB or USMS inmates. Any variation in the count is due to rounding.
