


## DC Department of Corrections Operating Budget and Net Expenditure






### Department of Corrections Full Time Employees



#### FY 2018 Budget by Service




#### FY 2018 FTE Distribution by Grade





#### Average Daily Population FY 2018 by Sex and Facility












Average Daily Population by Calendar Year





#### Age Distribution of Inmates









#### Length of Stay Distribution for Inmates in Custody


•Pretrial Felon (PF) means at least one unresolved legal matter exists and indicates the most serious offense requiring detention is a felony.

• Pretrial Misdemeanant (PM) means at least one unresolved legal matter exists and indicates that the individual has no felony offenses.
• Parole Violator (PV) indicates an individual who has violated conditions of parole, probation or release.

\*Sentenced Felon (SF) indicates the inmate is serving at least one sentence and indicates the most serious offense requiring detention is a felony.

•Sentenced Misdemeanant (SM) indicates the inmate is serving at least one sentence and indicates that the inmate has no felony offenses.

•Writ/Hold (WH) individuals may have other charges (typically in transit, fugitive) requiring legal resolution. Only 4% of all inmates are detained sol..
